## PROCUREMENT OFFICER (01 POST)

Applications are invited from the citizens of Sri Lanka for the following post at the Tea Research Institute of Sri Lanka, Talawakelle.

### Job Description:

Responsible for procurement of all goods and services by following Government approved procurement procedures considering cost, quality, time, durability of goods and services under the supervision of Deputy Director (Administration)/ Senior Administrative Officer.

### External (01 or 02 below):

- A Bachelor's degree in Finance / Accountancy / Supply Chain Management / Business Management / Logistics Management / Commerce/Business Administration or any other degree relevant to the subject area of the post, which is recognized by the U.G.C.
- Having passed the intermediate examination of a recognized Professional Chartered Institute, of which the subject area is relevant to the post.

### Internal (01 or 02 below):

- 1. Having obtained the qualifications required by the external candidates above.
- Completion of minimum five (05) years satisfactory service in a post of the Management Assistant
  Non Technological Category (MA 1-2)/ Management Assistant Technological Category (MA 2-2)/ in
  Grade II, in the subject area relevant to the post.

**Salary Scale**: JM 1-2 (2016) Rs. 43,355/- 10 x 755 - 18 x 1,135 = Rs.71,335/-

Age: Should not be less than 22 years and not more than 45 years. The upper age limit will not apply to the internal candidates.

Method of Selection: By a Written Competitive Examination and/or a Structured Interview.

#### Other Benefits:

- Accommodation (fully furnished quarters) will be provided if available or an allowance will be paid
  in lieu of accommodation
